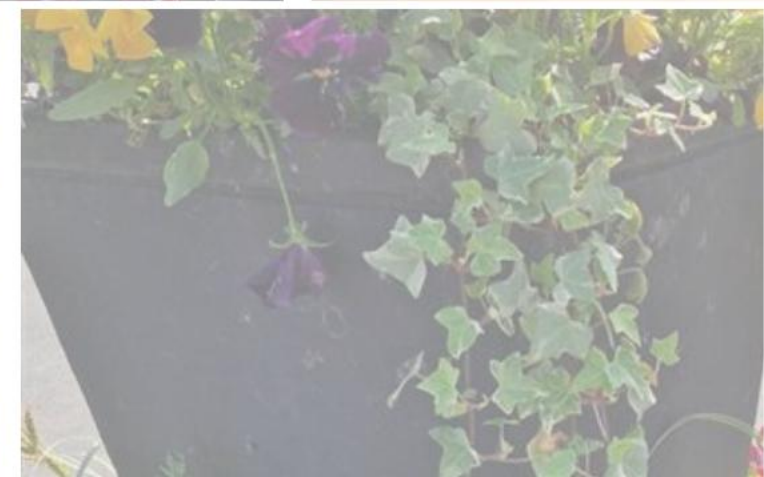

“The Parish Council is committed to communicating actively with residents and promoting community values, a healthy environment and pride in Church Crookham.”



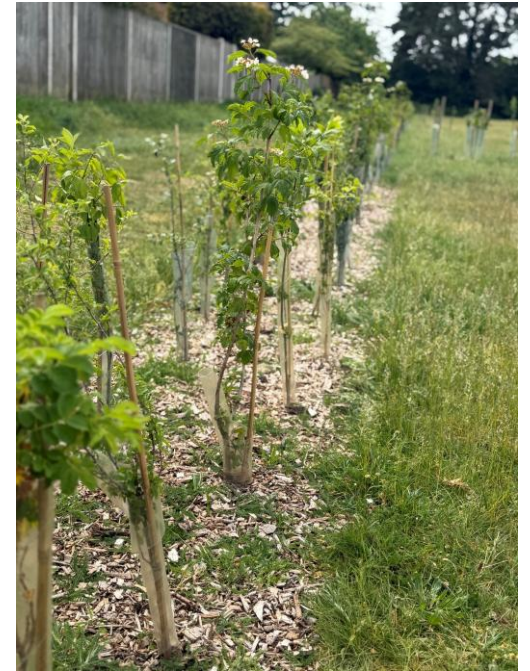
The Council's guiding principles are:

- We fixed the historic drainage issues
- Had the MUGA resurfaced
- Invested in new goals
- Provided alternative usage of MUGA with netball markings
- Planted new trees



- We plan to replace the MUGA lights with LEDs, add basketball hoops, revamp the pavilion and plant more trees.

Community Centre



- We added storage to the Acorn Hall to allow the preschool to pack away each night opening the space to hirers every weekday evening.
- We refreshed the outdoor space too.
- The Christmas lights were renewed, and the 2nd tree was wrapped this year.

Allotments

- Added a delivery bay for woodchip storage to maintain a tidy car park
- Added a toilet



Events

- The PC runs two annual events, the Spring Festival in May and a Christmas Festival. They could not happen without the support of volunteers, Fleet Flyers, the Lions Club, the Men's Shed, our staff (and their families) and councillors or the support of our wonderful community
- We also celebrated our 10-year anniversary at Church Crookham Community Centre

Other

- Added QR codes to the external bins (to help residents report issues)



- Made the flower displays across the parish all year round



- The PC purchased new speed indicator equipment (and supports the community Speed watch)



Other

- Signed new grounds maintenance contracts to appoint a specialist sports turf contractor for football and athletics areas (and is in receipt of a grant to improve the football pitches)
 - Appointed a new cleaning contractor
 - Continue to hold regular meetings with the developer of Crookham Park to hold them to account to address outstanding issues
 - As well as liaising with external bodies, our schools, and other councils. The list includes Hampshire Police, Farnborough Airport Consultative Committee, Alms Houses, Hart District Assoc. Parish & Town Councils

- **We will be looking to upgrade our CCTV coverage, add a noticeboard at Northfield Rd, and are working on a Church Crookham history trail for people of all ages to follow.**

Community Support

- We have committed ongoing annual support to Basingstoke Canal, Fleet Connect, and Fleet Phoenix.
- Fleet Phoenix have run free summer projects on Crookham Park for 2 years and is back in 2026.

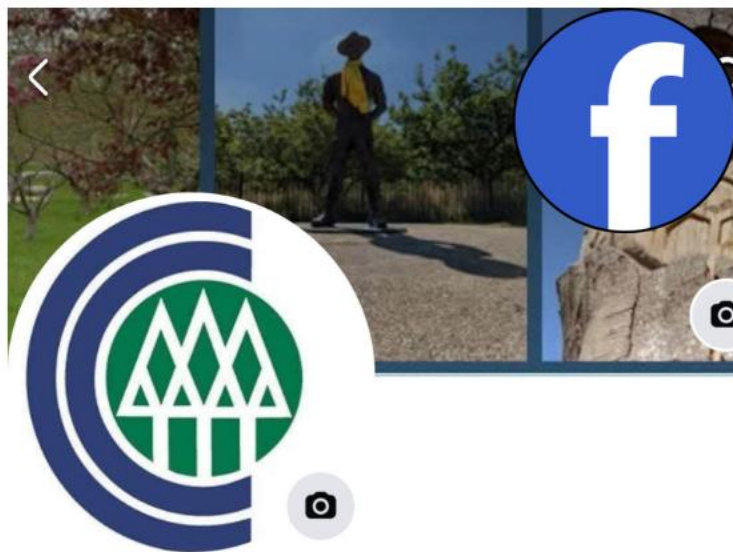

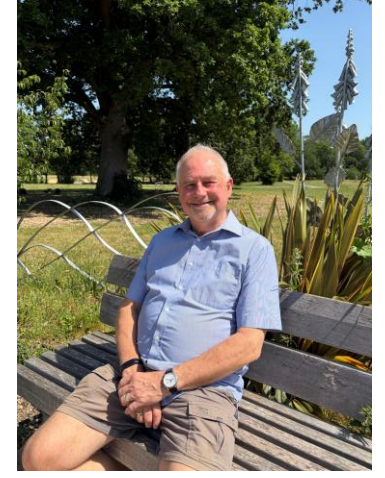

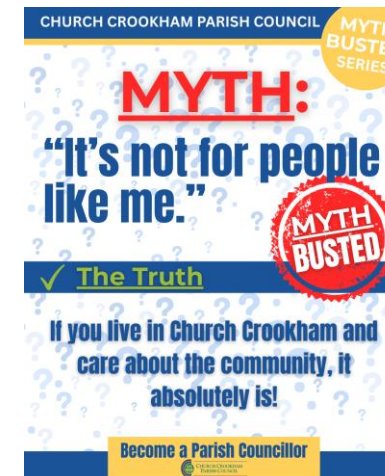
